Programme Objective

The objective of this programme is to extend learners understandings through practical learning experiences in the history, culture, healthy living, life styles, work, business, study skills and optional sport, arts and recreational activities and English language, enjoyed by in the past and in contemporary New Zealand. Learning especially focuses on developing the knowledge and skills to locate employment or a career pathway in New Zealand.

What you can expect?

Enjoyable and friendly small active group learning sessions taught by outstanding facilitators who will focus on your individual interests and goals along with experiences and visits to places of interest that relate to and support your learning. You will meet real New Zealanders and see how they live their lives plus experience the pure New Zealand heartland environment. Learning especially focuses on developing the knowledge and skills to travel or live in New Zealand independently and possible work or career options in New Zealand.



Programme Content

The programme consists of five papers. Three are compulsory. Programme content includes study of New Zealand culture, history and healthy living and lifestyles, English in New Zealand, working, business and sport, arts and recreation or special student selected study area. This programme focuses on living in New Zealand. Learners may also undertake a trip together.

Entry Criteria

Entry to this programme is open to national and International applicants who must be 18 years of age or older. There is no English language requirement for any applicants to this programme. Applicants may be interviewed and their suitability for the programme evaluated. Note; this programme may be studied on Visitor Visa. The learner groups targeted for entry to this programme are;

national learners, new migrants, refugees, international learners considering or studying in New Zealand, and those wishing to learn about New Zealand culture.
