Faculty Spotlight: Vanita Rae Smith



Vanita Rae Smith, Chief of Army Entertainment and Director of Army Community Theatre (ACT) at Fort Shafter presented 24 seasons of Broadway Musicals and 12 seasons of Readers Theatre plays. ACT was the first community theatre in America to secure the right to MISS SAIGON, CATS and CURTAINS and Smith directed all three. She has guest directed 18 plays at Manoa Valley Theatre, produced and directed hundreds of plays/musicals/celebrations and concerts for the U.S. Army during her 42-year career. Smith states: "Certain people are given a creative gift and are "called out" for the work of God's purpose, to use the arts to change people's souls, not for fame or fortune."



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
