ORDINANCE NO. _____-2017

AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 7 TO REMOVE THE SPECIFICATION OF SEATS ON THE IMPACT FEE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of Three Forks adopted Ordinance #299-2006/07 in April 2007 as allowed if a governmental entity intends to propose an impact fee ordinance, per Section 7-6-1604, MCA; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 the state law specified that the committee representation from at least one representative of the development community and one certified public accountant; and

WHEREAS, the Montana Legislature modified the law in 2015 and removed the need of a certified public accountant; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends updating the City's ordinance to reflect this change.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Three Forks City Council, that Title 3, Chapter 6, Section 7 is amended as follows:

TITLE 3, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 7: ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

The advisory committee is a standing committee established pursuant to Montana Code Annotated 7-6-1604. The advisory committee shall meet at the direction of the city council.

A. The impact fee advisory committee must have representation as defined by state law. The committee shall review and monitor the process of calculating, assessing, and spending impact fees;

SAVE AND EXCEPT for the amendments described herein, the remaining provisions of this Title, Chapter and Section are hereby confirmed and ratified as adopted.
