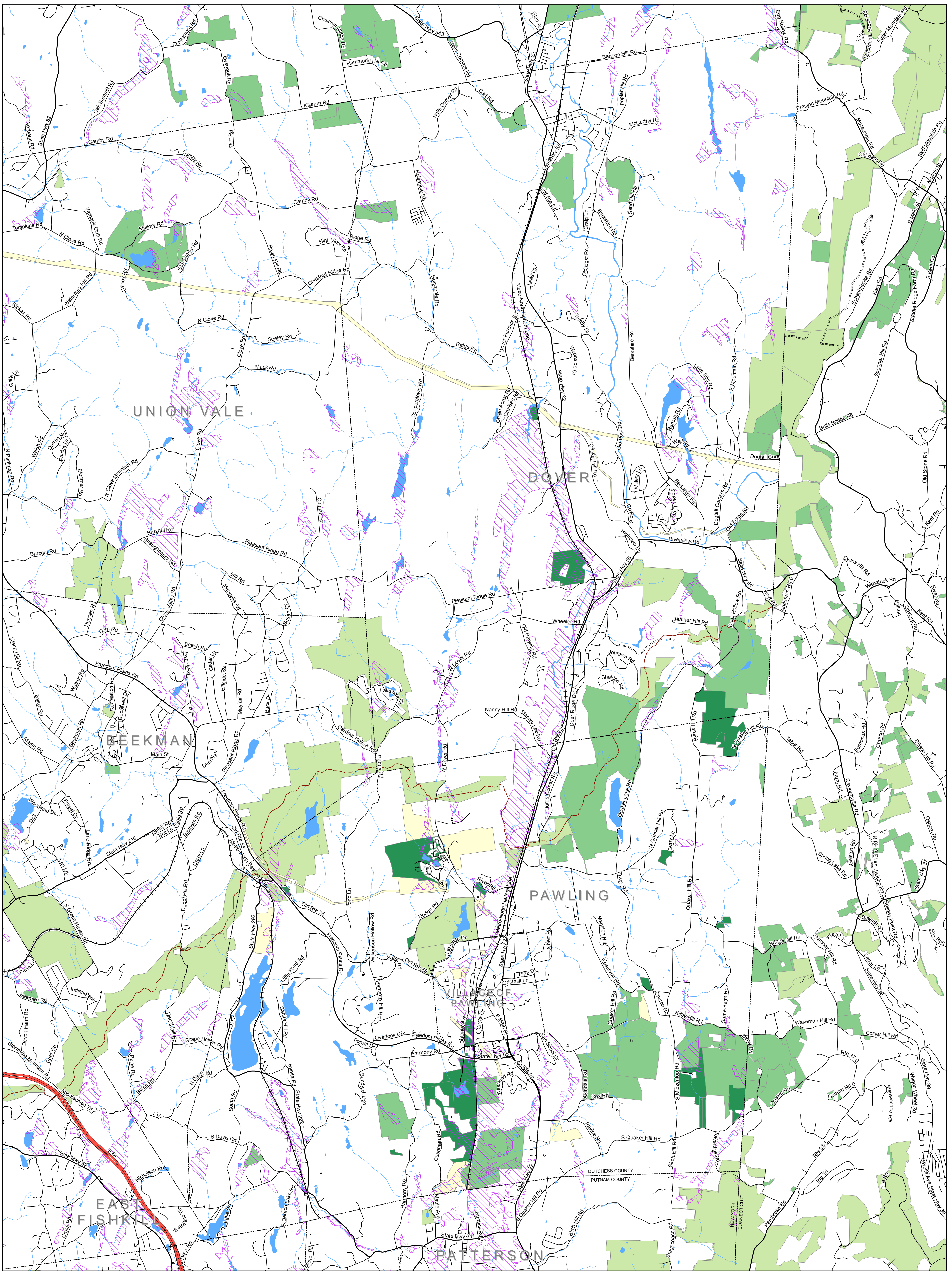


Oblong Land Conservancy - Conserved Lands

Town of Pawling, Town of Dover, New York and Surrounding Area

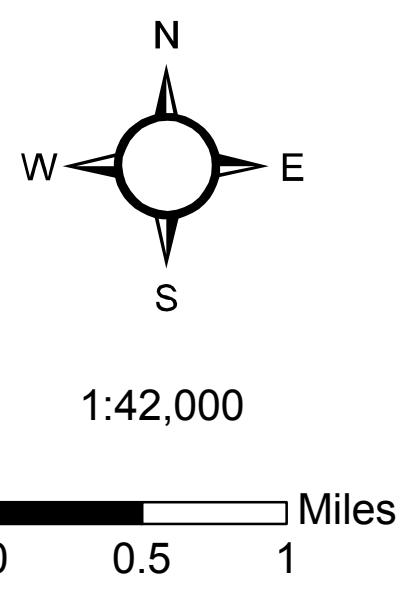
