## **STANISLAV CHERNYSHEV / CLARINET**

Clarinetist Stanislav Chernyshev, musician widely known in Russia (he was born in St. Petersburg), gives his concerts on the American stage and is rapidly gaining attention and love of the public, due to his extraordinary, soul-exciting musicianship, charisma and flawless technique. "Stanislav Chernyshev is silken-sounding clarinetist with impressive technique and amazing musicianship to go with."

Concerts of Mr. Chernyshev have been held with great success in the Kimmel Center (Philadelphia), Carnegie Hall (New York), St. Petersburg State Academic Capella and St. Petersburg Philharmonia (St. Petersburg, Russia), as well as in Switzerland, Spain, the Netherlands, Germany, South Korea and many other countries. He works with such conductors as Vasily Petrenko, Michael Stern, Robert Spano, Juanjo Mena, Yannik Nezet-Segun, participates in the concert programs of Mariinsky Clarinet Club (Russia). He was regular participant of the St. Petersburg House of Music projects (Russia) and Curtis on Tour (USA).

Mr. Chernyshev is a winner of the "International Competition of Wind Instruments" in the Ukraine, "2nd International Rimsky-Korsakov Competition"

in Russia, "LISMA Foundation International Competition" and "Mary Smart Concerto Competition" in the US. At the age of 19, Mr. Chernyshev won the Special Prize at the 62th Geneva International Music Competition in Switzerland.

Mr. Chernyshev graduated with honors from the Special Music School in St. Petersburg, where he studied with Professor Nikolay Kiruhin, and was awarded the Rostropovich Fund Scholarship. In 2014 Stanislav graduated from the Curtis Institute of Music (Professor Donald Montanaro) and St. Petersburg Conservatory (Professor Nikolay Kiruhin).

As a chamber musician, Mr. Chernyshev works with the world-renowned musicians such as Roberto Diaz (viola), Pamela Frank (violin), Ida Kavafian (violin), Peter Wiley (cello), Julian Milkis (clarinet), contemporary music ensemble "eighth blackbird" and many others. Stanislav works with such ensembles as Jupiter Chamber Players, Orpheus Orchestra, Novus NYC.

Projects with his participation are consistently noticeable and memorable. He works with the Project 440 and Savannah Music Festival in Georgia, Angel Fire Music Festival in New Mexico, Festival Daniou in Brittany, France.

As an advocate of new music, Stanislav works with such composers as Penderecki, Meredith Monk, David Lang, Rene Orth and many others. Mr. Chernyshev has recorded several CDs.

In February 2012, Mr. Chernyshev's recording in WQXR, the famous classical radio of New York, with Bob Sherman, has been a tremendous success. As the article to this radio recording says: "Host Bob Sherman heard him last summer at the Summit Music Festival in Purchase, NY, and was blown away." The deep, soulful, sophisticated style of performance testifies to the extraordinary musical talent.

Stanislav is a part of ensemble ACJW (a project of Carnegie Hall and Juilliard School), and a principal clarinet of the Symphony in C Orchestra.
