


Thank you for expressing interest in pursuing enrollment at North Christian School. We exist as a ministry of North Parkersburg Baptist Church to develop within our students, strong Christ-like character and academic excellence in a safe Christian environment. The school is fully accredited through AdvanceED, a nationally recognized organization, designed to ensure schools are equipped for promoting opportunities through learning.

We seek to provide a distinctive educational program in which we partner with the student's family and home church to foster well rounded instruction with the Bible as a core component in the curriculum. Our NCS families represent a variety of churches within our community. We have developed the following diagram to demonstrate how by partnering together, we have the ability to provide complete Christian education for our students and their families.



- + SCHOOL: NCS provides quality education to each student while integrating Biblical principles in curriculum and life skills.
- **HOME:** Principles are reinforced and modeled in the home by the student's family.
- + CHURCH: The home church provides theological and spiritual education through church services and aligns with what is being taught at school and home.

Our admission policy opens the school to families who are like-minded spiritually, who are supportive of our philosophy, objectives, and standards of education and whose children meet our enrollment qualifications. Our "Belief Statements" include:

At North Christian School, our objective is to provide a wonderful atmosphere and program equal with the highest standards attainable which will allow each child to develop at his/her own pace. Preschoolers at North Christian School are accomplishing great things. We offer developmentally appropriate instruction in Bible, Technology, Physical Education, and Spanish. All classes are led by Certified Teachers and our students enjoy weekly Chapel lessons, hand-bell instruction, and weekly cooking classes. Our preschoolers also partner with elementary classrooms where life-long friendships are formed, and learning is both engaging and stimulating.

North Christian School offers students an academically challenging curriculum which promotes high academic standards while helping the students to achieve skills in creative and critical thinking. Annually, our elementary students participate in the TerraNova 3 nationally standardized test. Our students consistently score above the National Average. The 2019 NCS averages scores were <u>ABOVE</u> National Averages of 50%. NCS Averages from 2019 are below.

• Reading Composite: 81%

• Mathematics Composite: 74%

• Language Composite: 78%

• Science: 76%

Social Studies: 76%

On the 2019 Bible Test, **32** students received national "Advanced" recognition status!

1. GOD IS THE CREATOR AND SUSTAINER OF THE UNIVERSE.

Christ is the recognized head of our church, not any person, group, or religious organization. While recognizing the value of associating and cooperating with other groups of Christians, we believe every local church should be self-governing and independent from denominational control.

6. PRIESTHOOD OF EVERY BELIEVER.

Christ loves us, and by his death he has freed us from our sins and made us a kingdom of priests to serve God.

The Bible teaches that every Christian is called to "full time" Christian service, regardless of his or her vocation. We practice the truth that every believer is a minister by encouraging every member to find a place of service and ministry. Every believer has direct access to God through prayer and Bible reading.
