
SMOKE & TOBACCO-FREE POLICY REPORT CARD

Rural Public College and University Summary

Annually, the California Youth Advocacy Network (CYAN) releases a report analyzing smoke and tobacco-free policies at colleges and universities in the state.

This Summary Report highlights smoke and tobacco-free policies at **public institutions** of higher education in California's **rural counties**. In 2024, 63% of public college and university campuses in rural communities were 100% smoke or tobacco-free.
