### FLORIDA AVENUE MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECT

(Washington, DC) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) invites you to a public meeting on **February 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017** to provide the community and stakeholders an update on the preliminary engineering of multimodal transportation improvement along Florida Avenue, NE from First Street, NE, to H Street/Benning Road, NE. The purpose of this project is to provide streetscape and traffic operational enhancements to improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists while ensuring all users have safe access within and through this important corridor. At this meeting, the 30% design plans will be shared to further refine the recommendations provided during the final design phase.
