TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

TEAM PARTICIPATION

- The 2017 Hawaii Futsal State Championships (“Tournament”) is open to teams in good standing with valid United States Futsal Federation (“USFF”) Passcards.
- Participants shall consist of 9-U (2008) to 16-U (2001).
- There is a limit of four (4) or six (6) slots per age group in each gender.
- An Online Tournament Application Form AND Team Entry Fee is required to secure a spot in the Tournament.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

 - *Early Entry: March 24, 2017*
 - *Final Entry: March 31, 2017*
- Complete and submit one (1) Tournament Application Form AND Team Entry Fee *per team*, via the online form at www.HawaiiFutsal.org.

TEAM ENTRY FEES

- **Early Entry Fee: \$475.00** (on or before March 24, 2017)
- **Final Entry Fee: \$550.00** (on or before March 31, 2017)
- Payment(s) shall be made online via the Tournament Application Form (www.HawaiiFutsal.org). [One (1) payment per team.]
- Team Entry Fees are non-refundable.

TEAM CHECK-IN

- All Teams must check-in at the time and location designated by the Tournament Director, prior to Tournament kickoff.
- A Team Representative may check-in Team(s) on behalf of a Coach.

GAMES

- All teams must be prepared to play one (1) or more games each day, anytime between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Games will be held at the Pana'ewa Covered Play Court.
- Each game consists of two (2) twenty (20) minute halves and one (1) five (5) minute halftime period. [Tournament Rules & Regulations 5(d), p. 3]
- Points are awarded for all games as follows:
 - 3 POINTS FOR A WIN
 - 1 POINT FOR A TIE
 - 0 POINTS FOR A LOSS [Rules & Regulations 6(b), p. 4]
- If there is a tie in points at the end of pool play or among the teams qualifying for the championship round in non-pool play, then the tie will be decided by using the following tie-breakers in the order in which they are listed:
 - 1ST TIE-BREAKER: HEAD-TO-HEAD-PLAY – The Team that won when the two (2) Teams met will advance. If still tied or if the teams did not meet;
 - 2ND TIE-BREAKER: GOALS AGAINST – Fewest goals allowed. If still tied;
 - 3RD TIE-BREAKER: GOAL DIFFERENTIAL – Total goals scored less total goals allowed with a maximum differential of three (3) per game. If still tied;
 - 4TH TIE-BREAKER: GOALS FOR – Total goals scored up to a maximum of four (4) per game. If still tied;
 - 5TH TIE- BREAKER: PENALTY KICKS – Time and place to be determined. [Tournament Rules & Regulations 6(e), pp. 4-5]

- In case of a tie at the end of regulation time, two (2) SUDDEN VICTORY OVERTIMES periods shall be played. The first Team to score a goal shall be declared the winner. If a Team is playing short due to send-off offenses, that Team will continue to play short during the overtime periods. The Teams shall change ends of the field after the end of the first overtime period.

TEAMS

- The minimum amount of Players is five (5) per team.
- The maximum amount of Players is twelve (12) per team.
- A Player can only be rostered on ONE (1) team, i.e., no double rostering.

TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

U.S. FUTSAL REGISTRATION

Team Players and Coaches who are not yet members of USFF may register at www.HawaiiFutsal.org. The Tournament is sanctioned by USFF—a member of the United States Soccer Federation—and shares the same basic protocol for complying with USFF registration requirements. Please be advised that there are USFF Registration Fees, which are SEPARATE from Tournament Team Entry Fees.

PROOF OF AGE

- Hawaii Futsal requires all participating players to provide proof of age at the time of Team Check-In (time, date, and location T.B.A.):
- Copies of birth certificates (for youths) and state/federally-issued identification cards (for adults) are acceptable.

PASS CARDS

- Digital photos of Players shall be uploaded during the online registration process.
- Official USFF issued Coach and Player/Member Passcards must be presented at the time of Team Check-In, prior to Tournament kickoff.
- All Coaches and Players are required to have USFF issued Member Passcards to be present in the designated Team Areas.

- Coach and Player/Member Passcards must be presented to the referee before the start of each match.

LAWS OF THE GAME

- All games are conducted under the rules set out in the latest version of the USFF Laws of the Game.
- The USFF Laws of the Game must be read together with the Tournament specific Rules and Regulations.
- USFF Laws of the Game and Tournament Rules and Regulations are posted online at www.HawaiiFutsal.org.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- Hawaii Futsal requires Players to wear matching uniforms (i.e., jerseys, shorts, and socks), with the exception of the Goalkeeper, who must wear colors easily distinguishable from the other players and referees.
- Jersey numbers in a contrasting color is required.
- Shin guards and flat, non-marking shoes are required. Turf shoes, or other marking type footwear are not allowed. Non-compliant players will be asked to leave the court to change footwear.

AWARDS

FIRST (1st) PLACE AWARDS:

Coach will be awarded the winner's trophy; Players will be awarded medals.

SECOND (2nd) PLACE AWARDS:

Players will be awarded medals.

PLAYERS' SOUVENIRS:

All Players and Coaches will receive a Hawaii Futsal State Championship souvenir. Teams are encouraged to bring pins, patches, or other souvenirs to trade with and/or to be given as gifts to opposing Teams and Referees.
