- No sheep will be allowed to compete if infected with foot rot or external parasites.
- Sheep entered in lamb's classes must have all milk teeth still in place. Lambs are not eligible for section championships.
- Best wether classes: Any wool type, judged on trueness to breed.
- The judge has the right to move any sheep to a different class if they deem the sheep is entered incorrectly.
