## SPECTATOR INFORMATION

The Rally in the Southern Ohio Forest can be a dangerous activity. For everyone's safety, it is important to observe the following:

- **NO ALCOHOL**
- **NO FIRES**
- **DO NOT cross barricades or banner tape**
- **DO NOT stand on the outside of corners**
- **DO NOT get closer than 100 feet to stage roads**
- **Cars will arrive at approximately one-minute intervals and there could be 5-10 minutes between vehicles. Stage is "HOT" until Sweep Vehicles have passed (Sweep Vehicles have yellow flashing lights)**
- **A stage is open to traffic only after green light vehicles pass through the stage**
- **DO NOT USE DRONES** - Drone use is not allowed at American Rally Association sanctioned events without direct approval by American Rally Association in advance.
- **Please leave area cleaner than you found it**



# SPECTATOR INFORMATION



Obey the organizer's instructions. If people are asked by the marshals to leave dangerous place on the SS route, they should follow these instructions. In case of indiscipline the special stage will be canceled!



Especially dangerous locations are marked as "PROHIBITED AREA" or "NO GO AREA". Do not try to enter these places, they can be terminally unsafe! Do not stand on "escape roads" as well. Do not cross the safety tape or net and stay behind it!



Keep the distance from the edge of the roadway. Keep in mind the high speed of competing cars. It is impossible to eliminate either the driver's mistake or an unpredictable technical defect of the vehicle.



Don't stay near bumps, crests or jumps located on the roadway. When the car lands off the ground, the driver has only small chance to control it. The car can easily leave the road after landing.



Don't sit by the SS route. Always watch, what's happening on the special stage. Think of quick evacuation of your place, at any time keep prepared an escape way and be prepare for quick reaction.



Avoid places below level of the route. Do not stand on outer sides of curves, in front of houses or other impassable obstacles. In forest do not stand in front of the trees. For watching the competition choose only places on elevated areas, behind solid obstacles etc.



Cooperate with Organizers and Route marshals, in case of menace of danger organizer must be informed about the current situation. In case of any accident spectators should wait with possible help on organizers' dispositions.



Do not cross the roadway and do not walk on the SS route during special stage! Take the position for watching the rally before start of first rally crews, not during the SS run! Count with time limits – take a look on the Rally guide in advance, when the SS route is going to be closed before the start and re-opened after the end. Remember that the route SS is not re-opened until the Organizer's vehicle passage!



Spectators are required to only park on one side of the road. We must leave one side of the road open at all times so ambulances, fire trucks, and police can respond in an emergency. Please obey the no parking signs so we have a safe event. Find an SOFR Volunteer for help.

## Forest Parking!

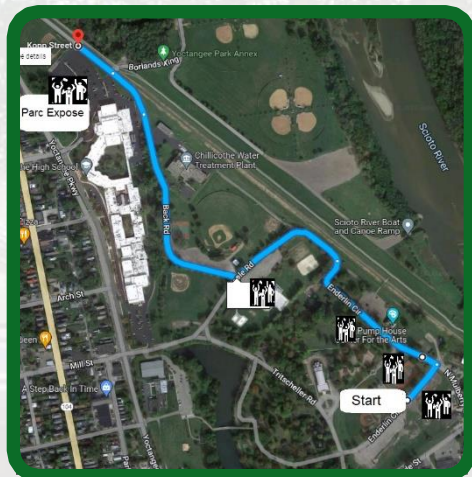

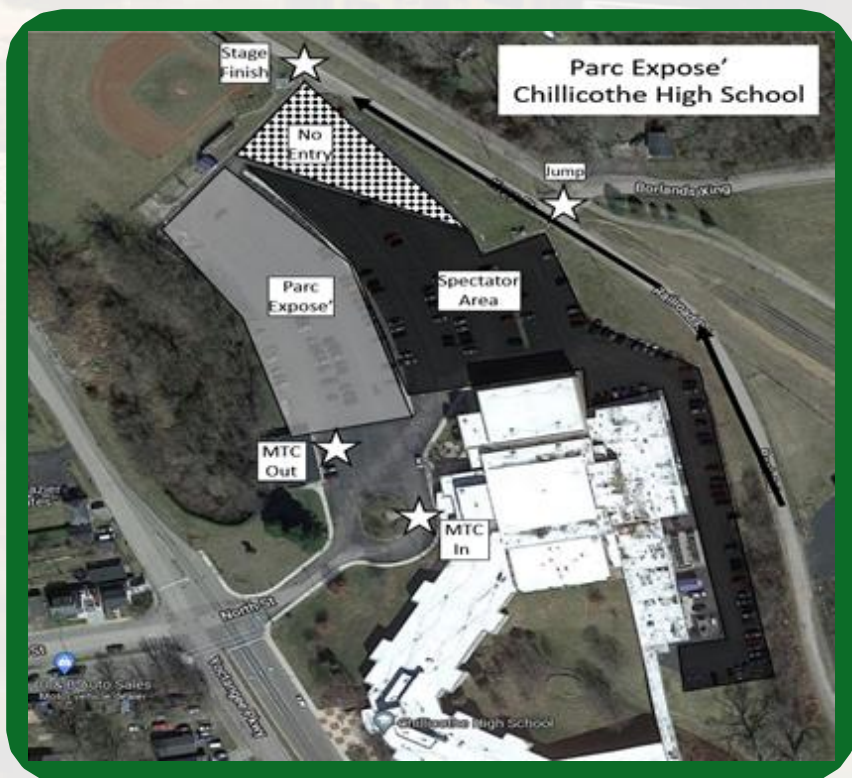

# FRIDAY - JUNE 7, 2024

## Spectator Directions From Portsmouth West School:

### Stage 2 & 6 \* New for 2024

- Right on SR 52
- 1.6 Miles Continue on US-52 E to OH-239 N. Take the OH-239 N exit from US-52 E
- 1.1 Miles Turn left onto OH-239 N
- 11.3 Miles Follow OH-73 W to OH-371 S in Union Township \* Left at Fire Dept
- Turn Left onto 371 (371 turns into State Forest Road #1
- After 3 miles look for Spectator Signs to spot

### Stages 3 & 7 – Horse Camp

- Right on SR 52
- 1.6 Miles Continue on US-52 E to OH-239 N. Take the OH-239 N exit from US-52 E
- 1.1 Miles Turn left onto OH-239 N
- 12.4 Miles Follow OH-73 W to Big Spruce – Little Bear Rd (Turn Left)
- 3.6 Miles Turn Left onto Pond Creek Bear Creek Rd into Horse Camp S(F RD 4)
- Drive Slow Follow Signs into Camp/Spectator Spot

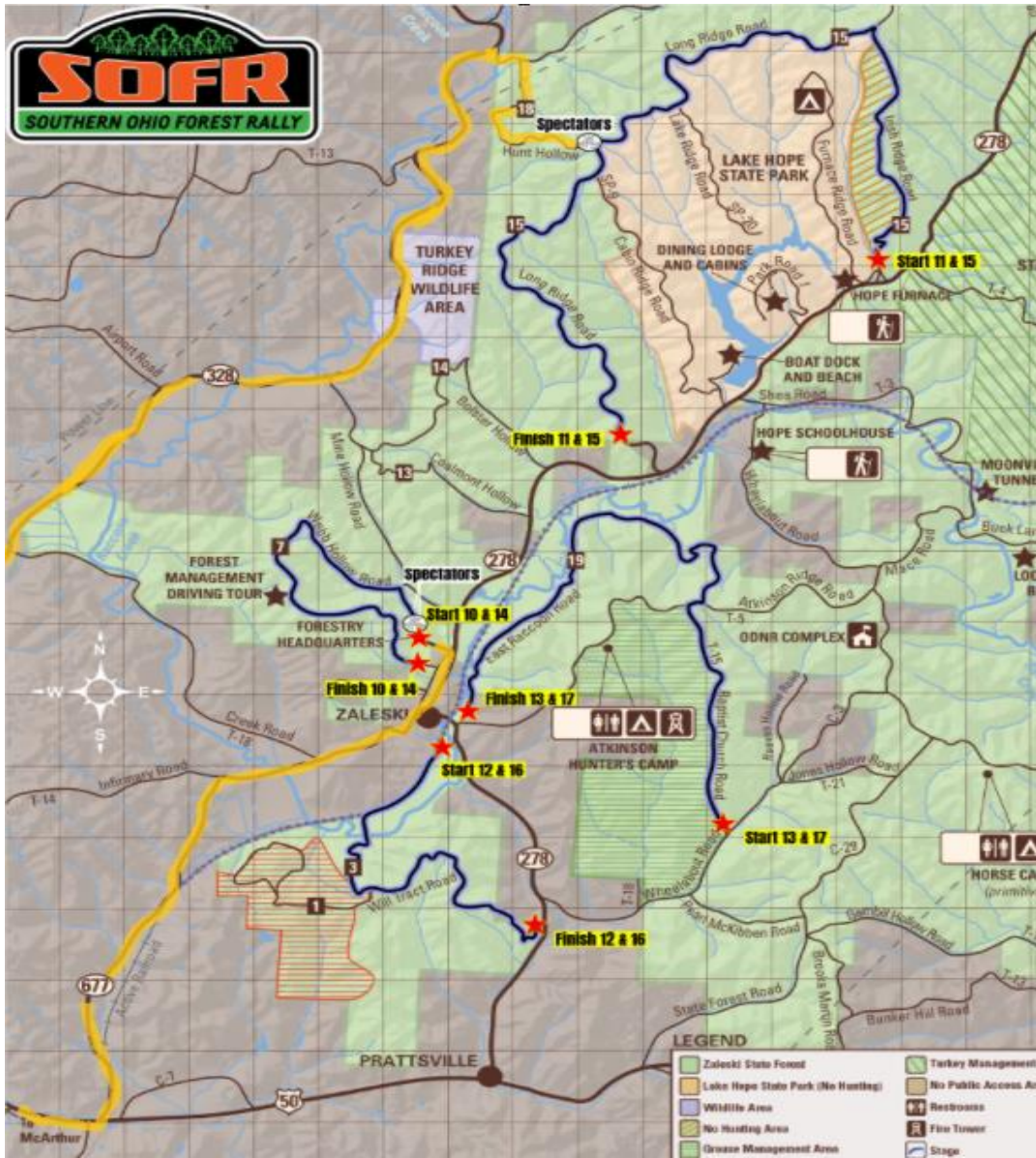
## Stages 10 & 14 - Zaleski Forest Office

Area closes at 7pm and gate will be locked!

- Take 50 East from Downtown McArthur \*Parc Expose
- 2.7 Miles Turn Left onto SR 677
- 4.8 Miles Turn Left into town of Zaleski onto SR 278
- 0.6 Miles turn left into Zaleski Forest HQ Drive Slow, watch for signs to Spectator Spot

## Stages 11 & 15 – Irish Ridge “America’s Best”

- Take S.R 93 North to S.R 328 from Downtown McArthur \*Parc Expose
- 3 Miles Turn Right onto S.R. 328
- 8.1 Miles Turn Right onto Two Mile Road
- .3 mile Turn Right onto Hunt Hollow
- Follow Signs to Spectator Point
