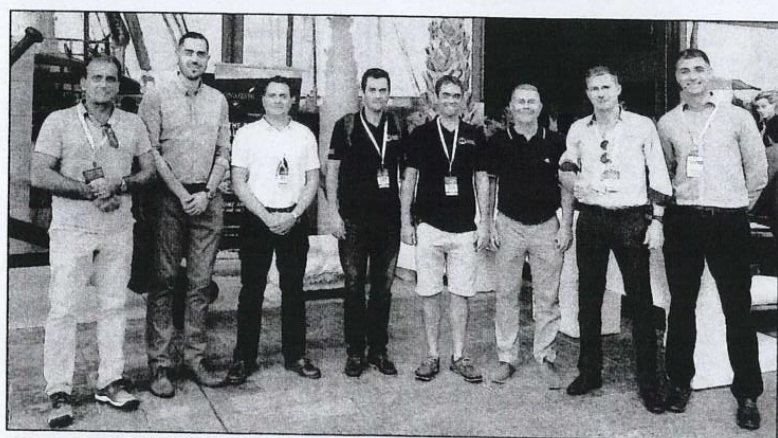
Gibraltar at the 2016 Monaco Yacht show
