The art classes are a smaller size so that every child can be given individual attention with their art learning. Therefore, places in the classes are limited. Please make enquiries first with the art teacher if you would like to enrol your child. It is important that your child is able to maintain concentration and enjoy classroom learning at this time of day.

I request children to remain in the art room at the end of class until collected. Arrangements can be made for your child to then attend after school care.

DAYS **TUESDAYS : Grade 3 to 6 children .**

There may be places available for Grade 2 students, particularly in the latter part of the year.

COSTS The costs are \$ 21.00 a class. Payment of \$210 a term, plus a materials charge of \$15 a term is made direct to the art teacher. The art classes are offered for a full term, and can then be continued. Children re-enrolling for subsequent terms have priority for a place in the art classes.
