WHY VOTE "BELOW THE LINE"?

"Below the line" is the only way to make your vote count.

If you vote "above the line" with just a "1" in a box... Beware, There is a catch!
Why risky? If your 1 "above the line" doesn't get in, they decide who gets your vote!

Yes - they decide - not you!

Eg. If you put "1" Above The Line for 'Liberal Democrats', and their candidate doesn't get in, Liberal Democrats give the vote to Family First. It's already "locked in"; there is no way your vote will go where you want. All the parties have done this.

Michael TUCAK is the only candidate who has not a preference deal like this.

Also beware, there are some 'fake' candidates in "above the line" voting".

So: Empower your vote! Vote "Below The Line".

By using "Below The Line" boxes, you alone decide exactly where your vote goes. There is no way that a party or 'fake' candidate can take control of your vote.

"Below The Line" helps you control where your vote goes!

HOW TO VOTE "BELOW THE LINE"?

It is very simple - just use the "Below The Line" boxes, and take your time.

You can start by adding a "1" next to Michael TUCAK. He is on the **right hand** "Independents End" of the Ballot Paper - just unfold it to the right-hand end.

Then, just add number 2 to 45 to the rest of the candidates (see overleaf).

THE BIG QUESTIONS:

Q. Why is there no box "Above The Line" for Michael TUCAK?

A. It's not a printing error! It is because Michael wants you to vote "Below The Line" to really make your vote count, and not get caught by "Above The Line".

Q. What do I do after the "1" for Michael Tucak? Turn the page!

Q. Can I add a box "Above The Line" for Michael TUCAK?

A. No - you can't alter the ballot paper other than adding your numbers.
Doing this may make your vote invalid!

SIMPLY NUMBER FROM 2 TO 45 IN THE ORDER YOU WANT – TAKE YOUR TIME, IT’S YOUR VOTE!

“THE GUNG HO”

Just GO FOR IT!

Put a “1” in Michael TUCAK below the line.

Step 2: Then just pick the order **you want** from 2 to 45 below the line.

Step 3: Go steady so you don’t miss a number or write one in twice.

Step 4: Once you reach 45, go back and check them all off again.

Take a look around and savour the moment
- **you just made your vote count.**

“THE TOP 5 AND BOTTOM-DWELLING 10”

Put a “1” in Michael TUCAK below the line.

Step 2: Number the next 4 candidates you like best – so it’s 2 to 5 done.

Step 3: Working backwards from 45 back to 36, number those you really don’t want to vote for – they’re your “bottom-dwelling 10”.

Step 4: Then, back to 6 and number candidates in groups of 10 all the way to 35 in the order you like.

You can break 6 to 35 down into 3 groups of 10, like this:

6 to 15 | 16 to 25 | 26 to 35

That’s you done. **Check your numbers back.**

“THE BUNCH OF FIVES”

Put a “1” in Michael TUCAK below the line.

Step 2: Number from 2 to 5 below the line. **Breathe.**

Step 3: Now just do 8 manageable sets of 5 at a time.

Cross check to this list as you go:

6 to 10 | 11 to 15 | 16 to 20 | 21 to 25
26 to 30 | 31 to 35 | 36 to 40 | 41 to 45

When you reach 45,
go back and check them all off again.

“THE RANDOMISER”

MEGA HIGH RISK!

Put a “1” in Michael TUCAK below the line.

Step 2: Then if you’re prepared to “get funky”, start numbering from 2 to 45 randomly across the paper. **Double-check your numbers.**

NOTE: This method is VERY RISKY!
You never know where your vote may end up if you go totally RANDOM!

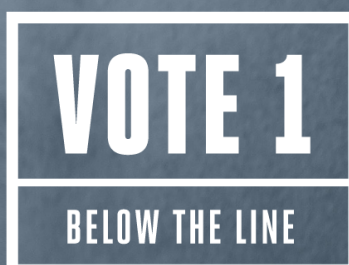
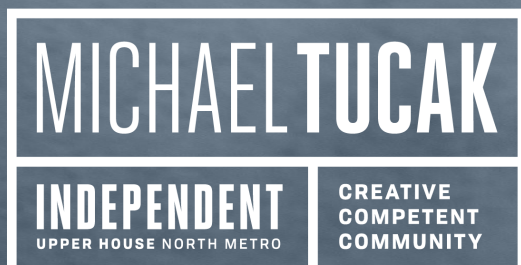
Once you’re done, DOUBLE CHECK the following red tape nasties:

- you have NO EMPTY BOXES “below the line”
- your writing is clear and you have no numbers or marks “Above The Line”
- you have not skipped or duplicated any numbers

WHO EXACTLY DO I PUT IN 2 TO 45?

Michael’s only “preference” is **you decide for yourself.** If you’re unsure, here are some useful tips:

1. Michael is an Independent, so he also supports the other “Real” independents listed after him.
2. Large parties like “Liberal”, “Labor”, “Greens” or “One Nation” will probably get in anyway - so you could put them toward the bottom of your 45.
3. Once you do put a number against Liberal or Labor, that is probably as far as your vote will go. So once you put them in your list, the rest of your preferences might never be used. However, it’s still worth doing the whole 45, to make your vote count.
