- The Easterns Virtual Leaderboard Series will consist of results compiled from all meets held at independent, tuition based schools that normally compete during the winter season as defined by NFHS and NISCA.
- ❖ All rules for NFHS and NISCA will apply to all competitions.
- Any independent, tuition based school that normally competes in the NFHS winter season may host a meet to be included in the Leaderboard Series provided they have facility availability and the necessary automatic timing equipment needed to run a meet.
- All participants must be members in good standing of their respective schools to be included in the official leaderboard results.
- There will be no qualifying times for the Virtual Leaderboard.
- Meets must be approved through your high school by your Athletic Director or Head of School.
- Officials are encouraged. If you cannot guarantee officials, please contact the meet directors for meet approval.
- ❖ Each host may determine if the meet is open to other schools or closed to only the school's current team members in order to comply with Local, State, and Federal requirements (ex. participant limits at indoor gatherings, facility guidelines, etc.)

- ❖ Meets must be held in short course yards (scy) and with the use of an automatic timing system (touchpads, timing console, etc..). Hand watch times will not be accepted for the Virtual Leaderboard.
- ❖ Individual events included in the competition will be the 50, 100, 200, 500 Freestyle, 100 Butterfly, 100 Backstroke, 100 Breaststroke, and 200 IM. Athletes are permitted to submit times for any number of events. Athletes may have only one time on the leaderboard per event, but that time can be updated based on subsequent competitions.
- Relay events are limited to 1 school team submission per event in the 200 Medley Relay, 200 Free Relay, 400 Free Relay.
- Diving can submit a 6 dive dual meet result and/or an 11 dive championship competition result.
  - > 6 Dive the required dive is a front dive with a maximum Degree of Difficulty of 1.8.
  - > 11 Dive all divers will be required to do 5 voluntary dives, one from each category.
  - ➤ <u>In order for a score to be considered, approved officials must be present to judge the diving competition.</u>
- ❖ Meets must be held between January 15 and June 1 for submission.
- Meet information for approved competitions must be submitted in advance of the meet to the Easterns Meet Committee for evaluation and approval. <u>Please click here to fill out a meet</u> <u>approval form.</u>
