Thursday, January 18 at 6:30pm/KidZone Gym

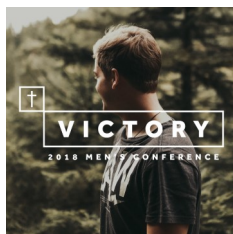
