Edmonton-based King of Foxes offers a powerful blend of garage rawness and alt rock influences. They have drawn comparisons to Veruca Salt, Lush, and Metric, but retain an edgy persona led by Olivia Street's elegant, pop-tinged vocals and Brandon Baker's seeing-eye guitar hooks. *Golden Armour*, King of Foxes' first full-length release, crosses a lot of different genres—incorporating elements of 90s grunge, alt country, retro pop—and yet it has a cohesive sound that comfortably re-configures the genres it draws upon.

Produced by Stew Kirkwood of Sound Extractor Studios in Edmonton, the album was funded in part by a \$10,000 "10k20" grant from the Jim Pattison Group. *Golden Armour* charted on the Canadian independent music charts for 17 weeks, including frequent airplay on CBC 90.9, CKUA 94.9, and CJSR 88.5.

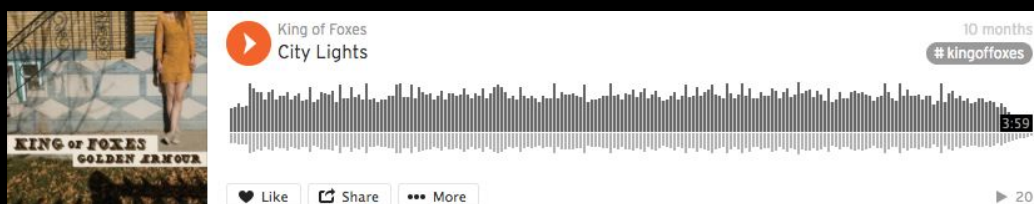
