School Uniform Items in good condition. (If there is someone who has time to launder these donated items and then deliver to the appropriate school that would be very useful)

### **Sponsorship Opportunities**

Birth Certificate (\$33)

- Gives individual an identity. Important as required for job applications, drivers licence, bank accounts and Work & Income)

School Camp Fees (Approx. Cost \$150.00 per child) Many families are unable to find extra funding for their children to attend school camps. While the school often has some funding available that it not always the case.

Elim Day-care for at-risk pre-school child under 3 (Approx. cost \$6.00 per child per hour. May be less if a subsidy is available to the family)

Powerzone Afterschool Programme (Approx. \$12.00 per child per day from 3pm to 5.30pm) This is a positive, secure fun environment where vulnerable children can have afternoon tea and interact with other children for a couple of hours after school.

Elim School Holiday Programme (Approx. cost \$38.00 per day or \$190.00 per child per week, may be less if a subsidy is available for the family) This allows vulnerable children a week in a secure, positive environment.

Bridge Valley Adventure Camp. This is a school holiday programme and the cost is approx. \$180.00 per child per week. This is a positive learning environment where children from 8 to 13 years stay overnight Monday to Friday. [www.bridgevalley.co.nz](http://www.bridgevalley.co.nz)

### **Camp Items (equipment pool)**

Kay is looking to have a pool of equipment required for children to attend school camps and this would be lent to the children and then returned and re-issued as required.
