From the birth of Goshen Homes until now we have kept 119 children together with their siblings.

FOSTER

Primary Families provide care to children that live in their home for the entirety of their time in foster care. They partner with biological families and meet the needs of the children while the parents work their case plan.

Respite Families offer relief care to primary families by taking in foster children on a more temporary, short term basis. We like to think of this as a visit to the cool aunt and uncle or fun grandparents.

FAMILY SUPPORT

We have several ways to serve families and children. Our parents are always welcoming meals and other donations.



The Journey to Becoming a Foster Parent



GET INFORMATION

The first step in fostering with Goshen is a simple phone call or meeting with one of our staff. This gives us an opportunity to get to know you and your family. This is when you can get your initial questions answered and see if we are the right fit for you. After this we would have an information session where we take a deeper look at foster care and being a foster family with Goshen Homes.




GET TRAINING

Our 6-part IMPACT training is engaging, relevant and practical, preparing you to care for your foster youth. This is a state required training and it is the crash course on all things foster care. Goshen Homes has developed a special IMPACT training that teaches the state curriculum with the added Goshen difference. Each session you will laugh, possibly cry and enjoy engaging with other new foster parents. In the end, you will walk away with a better understanding of what children face in foster care, how to partner with DFCS and be better prepared to begin your journey as a Goshen Homes family.



After IMPACT is completed, we begin the home study. Both primary and respite foster homes need home studies to be licensed. The Home Study is the last step required before your home can be open to caring for foster children. The well-being of the children in our care and your family is our top priority. The home study is where we diligently ensure your home and family is ready in every aspect for the challenges and blessings fostering can bring. Goshen staff will make multiple visits to your home in order to complete your home study. These visits will help ensure that you are prepared to make this commitment that will change the lives of the children you are serving.



START FOSTERING

Your paperwork is turned in. Your training is completed. Your home is licensed. You're almost there! Now we just need to match you with children needing a foster home. Each family has the opportunity to make preferences of age and gender of the kids that will work best with their family. Once we know what works for you, our Goshen Placement Services team will begin the search for the right sibling set.

We want to enable you to be the best foster parent that you can be! In order to help you succeed, we connect you with childcare and respite to give you some time to recharge. We provide the required training and offer additional therapeutic training to equip our families. In addition, Goshen Homes has a monthly support group for our families to connect and encourage each other.
