

You Are Invited to Attend a Public Workshop Regarding the Priority Area 1 Specific Plan

The City of Brentwood is in the process of creating a specific plan for approximately 400 acres located within the northwestern portion of the city and identified as Priority Area 1 in the City's General Plan. The General Plan designates the majority of this area (approximately 250 acres) as Mixed Use Pedestrian Transit, which is intended to provide a mix of predominantly jobs-generating and commercial uses with integrated higher density residential development in a transit village format. The purpose of the workshop is to:

- Communicate the intent of the Specific Plan
- Receive public input on the vision for the area
- Identify goals and priorities for the area
