A Louisville native and son of John and Lynda Wilcox, he left the Ohio River Valley in 21001 and returned in the spring of 2016. Within those 15 years he lived and traveled extensively throughout the continental United States. The exposure to cultural dynamism and diversity is evident in the wide range of styles, mediums, and techniques which are found throughout the body of his work. Though his work is highly abstract it is contextualized by the intentions of the artist himself.

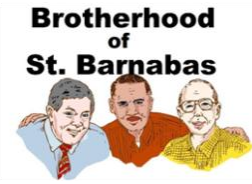
## No Bible Study or Holy Eucharist on Tuesday, April 17 and April 24
