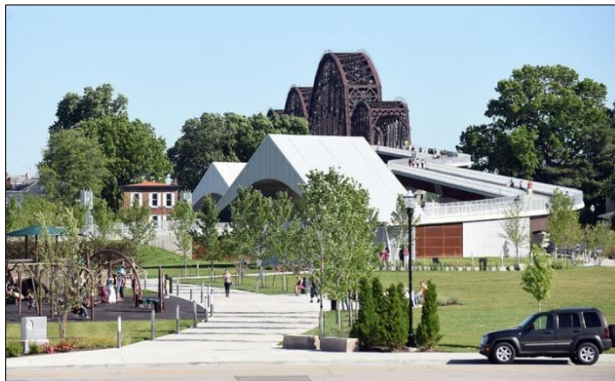

Holy Hikes will walk the Big Four Bridge on Saturday, May 12. Gather at 9:00 am at the base of the bridge in the Big 4 Station Park in Jeffersonville. Holy Hikes-Southern Indiana is a ministry bringing people together in the beauty of creation, celebrating the Liturgy of Word, prayer & Eucharist. A Liturgical Hike is a celebration of a liturgy (i.e. church service) in the context of a hike. The services are

stational, meaning we do the service throughout the entire hike with stations along the way. Although a ministry of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in New Albany, Indiana, you do not need to be an Episcopalian to participate. All are welcome to join in communion during the hike.
