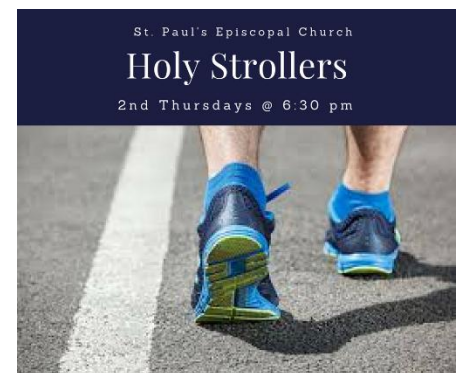


Summer Community Service Opportunity
