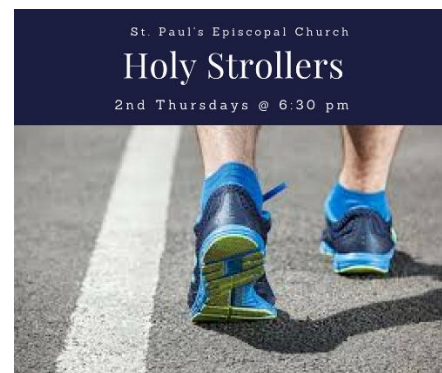
## For June, St. Paul's Helps HOPE, Southern Indiana
