The reading will be followed by a discussion with the author and the cast. Admission is free. Refreshments will be available before the show. This reading is rated PG-13.

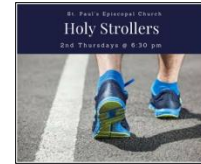
Coffee Hour Hosts/Hostesses Needed for July and August

St. Paul's Holy Strollers - Thursday, July 12

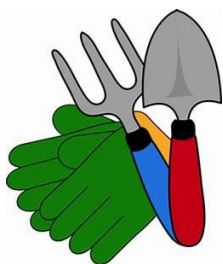

At the "T" intersection of Ridgefield Road and Sheridan Ave, turn right and follow Sheridan Ave into the Metro Parks parking lot.

Calling All Gardening Enthusiasts - An Invitation to Get Grounded in Beauty!



Help is needed to keep our campus gardens looking good (and staying healthy) through the summer months. I've been trying to keep the new groundcover beds weeded (the 2 Main St. corners in front of the Parish House and between the church and handicap ramp near Market St), but that came to a screeching halt recently when a very painful flair up of carpal tunnel has put me on the sideline (in both gardening and music... my 2 favorite hobbies... ouch!) Can someone step up?

Early morning or evening is the best time to work during this heat wave. The corner at Main St. and our alley is fine, but I only got 2/3 of the way through the Main/11th St bed before I was sidelined... you can tell what hasn't been done! Also I've not touched the Market St. bed, but it isn't too bad and 20 minutes should get that back in order. These need to stay weeded (by someone careful enough to not pull out the ground cover vinca!) so that the ground cover has a chance to fill in. Once it's filled in, the weeding needs will decrease dramatically, but these first 2 years are crucial.
