Me and my big mouth.

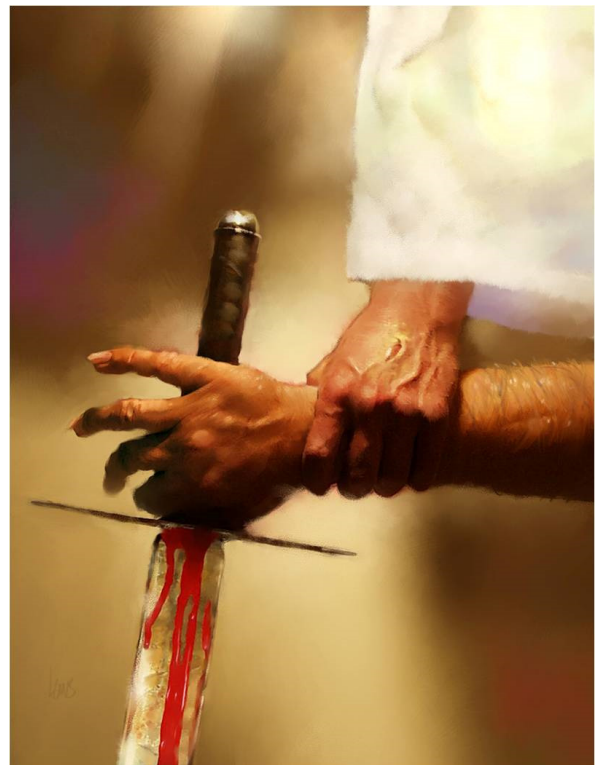
He said I’d deny Him three times before the rooster crowed.

“As if the Master didn’t know, He asked, ‘Whom do you seek?’

“When He said, ‘I am He,’ they fell to the ground, overwhelmed by the power of His words. As they struggled to stand, He asked again, ‘Whom do you seek? I am Jesus of Nazareth. It’s me you seek, let the others go.’

“Then Judas betrayed our Master with a kiss. I wanted to chop his head off. Caiaphas, the chief priest nodded to his servant, Malchus, to tie Jesus’ hands. When he reached toward my Lord, I chopped Malchus’ ear off. I was so confused when Master told me to put away my sword. Only hours earlier He told us to get swords. Anyway, you should’ve seen their faces when Jesus healed Malchus’ ear. It didn’t change their minds.

“They bound Jesus and took Him to the high priest.

“John and I followed. While warming my hands at a fire, servants twice accused me of being with Jesus. I denied it. Malchus’ relative said, ‘Didn’t I see you in the garden.’ I denied Christ again. Then the rooster crowed.

“Agony. I had denied my Lord just as He said. I ran, pounding my chest and howling all the way back only to find several other sniffling deserters. Our world crashed around us. Less than twenty-four hours before, we thought we’d be sitting on thrones beside our Lord.

“One by one, more disciples dragged in. Andrew recounted the horrors of our Lord’s beating with the cat-of-nine-tails, soldier’s playing games, and pounding a crown of thorns into the Master’s head. James described Jesus stumbling up Skull Hill carrying the cross on His shredded shoulders. He said they pounded nails into our Lord’s hands and feet. I just sat in silence.

“At 3:00, the whole world darkened. The sun couldn’t watch either. The earth quaked.

“Thomas darted in reporting priests ran out of the temple screaming because the veil to the Holy of Holies had ripped from top to bottom. Would we be blamed for that?

“Then, Bartholomew’s long dead grandfather and many others left their graves and wandered the streets. I trembled like a scared goat.

“Just before Sabbath began, John and his mother escorted Mary in. Sobbing, her clothes soaked in her Son’s blood, she slid to the floor. A cacophony of anguish rose from all of us.

“They had followed those who put our Lord’s body in a borrowed tomb. Upset, they didn’t have time to anoint His body properly because of the Sabbath, they decided to finish after the Sabbath.

“Instead of rest, the Sabbath was a day of grief, anguish, and confusion. We discussed the previous day’s happenings, but none understood. The words, ‘I have prayed for you’ repeated in my head. ‘Strengthen your brothers.’ But, how?

“Just before dawn, some women took myrrh and aloes to anoint Jesus’ body. Shortly after they left, they returned shouting, ‘He’s alive.’ An angel told them Jesus had risen and to tell me and the others to meet Him in Galilee. John and I raced to the tomb and found it empty. Was He really alive? He raised Lazarus. Could He...?

“Later that night, Jesus appeared to us through the locked door. He is alive! But, what would He think of my failure?

“I should’ve known. Our Lord had no anger for us, only love—only forgiveness.

“Shalom,’ He said. ‘As the Father has sent Me, so I send you.’ Then He breathed on us and said, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit.’ He opened our eyes to the truths He’d taught all along. Understanding came and courage with it. And, joy. Yes, joy so great it overtook my shame.

“Praise God. He is alive. Jesus has risen from the dead. He has paid the debt of our sins forever with His own blood. He brought forgiveness, not just for my sins, but yours, too. Praise God! Jesus is alive!”
