

BROOKLYN'S 150th KINGS COUNTY MEMORIAL DAY PARADE

MONDAY MAY 29, 2017 AT 11AM

LEADERS MUST CHECK-IN WITH THE STREET MARSHALS ON THE CORNER OF 77TH ST & 3RD AVE. STARTING AT 9:30AM. BUSES MUST DROP OFF ALL MARCHERS ON EITHER 4TH AVE. OR RIDGE BLVD. AND THE STREET THEY ARE TO LINE UP ON, (i.e. 76TH STREET & 4TH OR 78TH ST. & RIDGE BLVD). DO NOT DROP MARCHERS OFF ON 3RD AVE. THE LEADER MUST THEN REPORT TO THE STREET MARSHALS AND THE BUS CAN PROCEED TO THE END OF THE PARADE.

ALL LEADERS MUST REPORT TO THE STREET MARSHALS AT THE TENT ON THE CORNER OF 77TH ST & 3RD AVE. BEFORE 9:30AM.

PARADE KICKS OFF PROMPTLY AT 11 AM.

ROUTE OF PARADE: From 78th St. and Third Ave., along Third Ave. to Marine Ave., up to Fourth Ave. and over to John Paul Jones Park on 101st St. and Fourth Ave. for the memorial service. All marchers will enter the park in formation to pass in review by the grandstand. Marchers will then be directed to a location on the field for the ceremony. **NOTE: There will be no band performances in front of the grandstand.**
