Passing of CanSTAT member:

We are sad to inform you that long-time STAT member Tasha Miller died following a battle with cancer on Tuesday 8th September in Halifax, Nova Scotia, where she had been living and working as a teacher for the previous decade. Her departure was peaceful and without pain.

Tasha trained with Jeanne and Aksel Haahr at the Totnes Alexander Technique Training School in Devon from 1979-83. She taught in Cardiff from 1983-2005 before moving to Canada.

According to those who knew her personally, Tasha was a teacher of utter dedication and uncanny ability, whose effect on her students could be profoundly transformative. She had been amongst the most faithful and gifted exponents of the Alexander Technique.
