People's Liberty Globe Grants enable teams or individuals to take over a storefront space and transform it into a provocative, interactive experience that engages the surrounding neighborhood. In 2018, Globe Grants will be awarded to **six** teams or individuals to take over **one of two** spaces: the People's Liberty storefront at Findlay Market (FM) or the annex storefront in Camp Washington (CW).

Award

- \$15,000 award to support installation and programming.
- Work space at People's Liberty.
- Installation assistance and support for programming development.
- Coordination of an opening night kick-off.
- Promotion and storytelling support.

Restrictions

- Applicants must be 21 years old.
- Applicants must be citizens of the United States.
- Applicants must be residents of Greater Cincinnati and live within the 275 beltway.
- Applicants are not eligible to receive more than one grant per year from People's Liberty; (12 months from submission of final report of previous grant).
- Applicants may submit only one application for review during a grant cycle.
- Applicants may not be staff or immediate family member of employees or advisors of The Haile/U.S. Bank Foundation or People's Liberty.
- Applicants may not have served as a People's Liberty panelist or a Resident in the previous 12 months.
- Applicants are not eligible if they have previously received a Globe Grant.
- Applicants must be available for any of the six calendar time-slots for the year.

Requirements

- Applicants must have a proven track record of bringing ideas into action.
- Applicants must be committed to fulfilling all of the requirements and expectations outlined in this guide.
- Grantees must complete a W-9 and provide proof of identity and residency status.
- Grantees must understand and accept tax liability for funding received.
- Grantees must submit a final report about their completed project.
- Grantees are responsible for "staffing" the space on Saturdays and Sundays.

Expectations

- Grantees staff and program their space throughout the duration of their grant cycle.
- Grantees organize an opening night kick-off.
- Grantees maintain regular contact with the People's Liberty team throughout the term of the grant.
- Grantees promote People's Liberty and serve as creative/civic ambassadors.
- Grantees complete their project and submit a final report at the end of their grant cycle.

Eligible Expenses

- Programming and events.
- Supplies and equipment.
- Rentals.
- Installation support/vendors.
- Stipend for effort committed to installation.

Non-Eligible Expenses

- Deficits or expenses incurred prior to or after the grant period.
- Programs, projects or events that have already taken place.
- Scholarships, purchase of awards or cash prizes.
- Benefits or projects planned primarily for fundraising.
- Loans, interest on loans, fines, penalties or costs of litigation.
- Activities with a primary purpose that is religious or political in nature.
- Travel not related to the production of the project.
