FIRST READING:


ISAIAH 52:13-53:12

LK 23, 46. V. Ps 30, 2. 6. 12-13. 15-16. 17. 25




SECOND READING:

After the Gospel and Homily, the Intercessions are sung at the altar.


THE ADORATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

THE SHOWING OF THE HOLY CROSS

Father Abbot carries the Cross in procession through the chapel.

During the procession, the Cross is lifted up three times. Each time the following versicle & response is sung, all kneel and venerate the Cross briefly in silence.

HOLY COMMUNION

One of the priests brings the Blessed Sacrament to the altar. Father Abbot then begins the Our Father.

Communion is distributed in the normal way.

CONCLUDING PRAYER

Father Abbot recites the prayer over the people and all depart in silence.
