The emphasis is on “learning by doing.” Each day will be filled with demonstrations and exercises on courtroom skills such as opening statements, closing arguments, and direct/cross of chief witnesses. Faculty members will demonstrate each skill and tell you why they took a specific approach. You will perform exercises in small groups implementing these skills and receive suggestions for improvement. Space is limited to (40) participants, so please register early. Participants are expected to attend all three days. Navajo CLE credits will be given to those who successfully complete the program.
