SUBSHRUB

2 - 6' high, 4 - 5' spread.

Soft, green, velvety leaves.

Flowers yellow orange, to 2" across - April to May.

Native habitat: creosote bush scrub - dry rocky slopes below
2500' - east face of Laguna Mountains, north to Riverside
County, east to Arizona, south to Baja California.

Full sun.

Dry Soil. Good drainage.

Drought tolerant once established.

Blooming can be prolonged with some summer water.
