

Arctostaphylos densiflora 'Howard McMinn' McMinn Manzanita

MEDIUM SHRUB - evergreen
4 to 6' (to 8') high, equal spread.
Rounded, mounding, dense.
Leaves pointed, bark dark red.
Many clusters of pale pink flowers
- late winter, early spring.

Horticultural selection from
A. densiflora in north coast
foothills.

Full sun to part shade.
Frost resitant.
Can do with or without water.
Can be watered in summer,
but not too much. Overhead
watering causes dieback.

Long-lived and dependable.
Good for screens, specimens and mixed
plantings.
One of the best manzanitas for coastal
and inland gardens.
Can be pruned to reveal interesting
branch structure.
Resists oak root fungus.
