ANNUAL

Spreading to 3' long.

Leaves fleshy.

Flowers pink to bright magenta - all year.

Native habitat: sandy areas, creosote-bush or coastal sage scrub below 5500' - south coast and desert, California to Arizona, New Mexico and Nevada.

Full sun.

Sandy soil.

Dry conditions.

Good for sandy slopes.
