

Arctostaphylos patula (*A. patula* ssp. *platyphylla*)
Green Leaf Manzanita

SHRUB, evergreen.

To 3–10' high, up to 12' wide.

Leaves almost round, bright green and shiny.

Flowers pink — January to February.

Smooth red stems.

Native habitat: montane chaparral, conifer forest, 2500' to 10000' — High North Coast Ranges, High Cascade Range, High Sierra Nevada, San Gabriel Mountains, San Bernardino Mountains, San Jacinto Mountains; to Washington, Montana, Colorado, New Mexico, Baja California.

Full sun to shade.

Does not tolerate salt in soil or water.

Little water needed once established.

Attracts hummingbirds.

Berries edible.
