SHRUB, WOODY PERENNIAL

To 3 - 4' high, spreading

Leaves smooth above, slightly woolly beneath.

Flowers pinky white, berries red turning brown.

Native habitat: Chaparral, coast of San Digo County. Not a "garden species" but probably suitable for planting in chaparral landscapes.

Full sun to part shade.

Does well in rocky areas.

Large basal burl.

RARE - CNPS List 1B.1

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere. Seriously endangered in California). **Federally endangered.**
