

*Carex praegracilis*  
Clustered Field Sedge

PERRENIAL (grasslike).

Small clumps to 1' high, spreading from rhizomes to 2' wide.

Leaves narrow, dark green, mostly in 5" tufts.

Inflorescence usually dense gold-brown.

Native habitat: alkaline or moist soils below 5,500' - throughout California.

Full sun to shade. Frost resistant.

Needs moist soil Water 4 x /month.

Can be used as groundcover, lawn substitute - great for kids, dogs and young-at heart adults.
