

*Crossosoma californicum*  
Catalina Crossosoma,  
Catalina Rockflower

SHRUB, SMALL TREE - deciduous.

To 16' high.

Leaves pale green, to 3".

Flowers have round white sepals and petals.

Native habitat: Dry rocky slopes and canyons below 1,500' -  
Palos Verdes Peninsula, San Clemente Island, Santa Catalina  
Islands and Guadalupe Island.

Full sun.

Drought resistant.

Good drainage.
