

Dudleya saxosa ssp. *aloides*

Panamint Liveforever, Desert Dudleya

SUCCULENT

Rosette.

Leaves to 6 inches long, lance-shaped with pointed tip.

Stems unbranched.

Flowers yellow to green/yellow, sometimes with red tinges, on stalks to 12" tall - April to June.

Native habitat: Shaded, rocky slopes below 6000' - Peninsular Ranges to Desert Mountains to northern Baja California.

Good in rock gardens.

Shade to part shade.

Good drainage.

Needs some water if grown in pots.
