

Dudleya traskiae

Santa Barbara Island Liveforever

PERENNIAL HERB, evergreen.

Forms rosettes 3 to 6" wide.

Leaves thick with powdery coating, pointed tip.

Flowers in a peduncle, mustard yellow — May to July.

Native habitat: steep slopes below 400' — Santa Barbara Island.

Part shade.

Best in well drained soil.

Good in xeriscape, rock gardens. Can be grown in pots.

Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies.

RARE — CNPS List: 1B.2

(Rare, threatened or endangered in California and elsewhere. Fairly endangered in California).
