

Eriogonum cinereum
Ashyleaf Buckwheat

PERENNIAL, SUBSHRUB - evergreen.

2 - 6' high, 2 - 6' spread.

Mounding.

Small leaves, gray-green above, whitish below.

Cream to pinkish flowers - June to December.

Native habitat: beaches, coastal bluffs - coastal sage scrub foothills under 1500' - Los Angeles to Santa Barbara Counties.

Full sun.

Well-drained, sandy soil.

Tolerates salt spray, wind.

Little (1 x /month) to no summer water.

Good for slope stabilization and borders on coast.
