



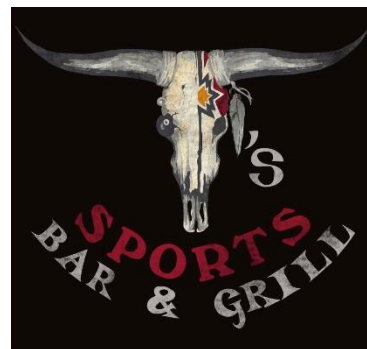

ATTENTION COOKERS

1. This is a CTBA - Central Texas Barbecue Association sponsored Sanctioned Cookoff.
2. Head cooks are responsible for the actions of guests at their campsite. Vulgar and obscene language will not be tolerated. This is a family event and we would like to keep it that way. Please keep in mind that other teams may not like your choice of music, so please keep it at a level that does not interfere with other teams.
3. For health and sanitary reasons, we ask that no pets be allowed in the cook-off site area.
4. Cook-off officials will enforce all rules. Failure to comply with a cook-off official will result in your team being disqualified and having to leave the premises.
5. We ask that you please keep your campsite clean and dispose of your trash in one of the dumpsters or trash cans provided throughout the cook-off area.
6. There will be a cook's meeting at **7:30PM on Friday, September 24th.** Head Cook's OR a designated team member will be required to attend. Plates & Cups for all entries will be passed out at the meeting.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

INTRODUCTION

1. CONTESTANTS MUST SUPPLY ALL NEEDED EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES. T'S SPORTS BAR & GRILL WILL PROVIDE SPACE AND TURN IN CONTAINERS ONLY. NO WATER OR ELECTRICITY WILL BE AVAILABLE.
2. T'S SPORTS BAR & GRILL WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY THEFT OR DAMAGE.
3. T'S SPORTS BAR & GRILL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE ANY ADDITIONAL RULES OR REGULATIONS AS SITUATIONS WARRANT.
4. DECISIONS OF THE HEAD JUDGE WILL BE FINAL.
5. THE BAR-B-QUE CONTEST WILL BE LOCATED AND HELD AT T'S SPORTS BAR & GRILL - 273 FARM TO MARKET 845 - CAMERON, TEXAS. JUDGING TURN IN LOCATION WILL BE IN THE FENCED IN AREA BY THE PICNIC TABLES.

ADMINISTRATION

1. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST CHECK IN AND SET UP THEIR SPACE BEFORE 7:00PM ON FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 24, 2021. SET UP MAY BEGIN ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 2021. ANY PERSON NEEDING TO CHECK IN AFTER 7:00PM WILL REQUIRE PRIOR CONSENT FROM THE HEAD JUDGE OR COOK-OFF OFFICIAL.
2. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE AT THE JUDGING AREA AT THE ASSIGNED TIMES. THERE IS A 5 MINUTE WINDOW ON TURN IN TIMES. ENTRIES ARE ACCEPTED STARTING AT 5 MINUTES BEFORE TURN IN TIME UNTIL 5 MINUTES AFTER TURN IN TIME. IT IS THE CHIEF COOKS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE ENTRIES GET TO THE TURN IN LOCATION ON TIME.
4. EACH TEAM WILL BE ALLOCATED A SPACE WHICH ACCOMMODATES ONE TRAILER OR ONE MOTOR HOME, ONE VEHICLE, BBQ PIT - TENT. EACH CONTESTANT IS RESTRICTED TO ONE MOTOR HOME OR R/V IN THEIR SPACE.
5. THE CHIEF COOK WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF HIS/HER TEAM AND THEIR GUESTS. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BE SOLD TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC BY CONTESTANTS.

NOTE: STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT YOU BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE TO CONSUME ALCOHOL! ANYONE VIOLATING THIS LAW WILL BE ACCOUNTABLE FOR THE CONSEQUENCES.

CTBA RULES

These rules are subject to change. See CTBA website for complete set of CTBA rules.

1. **COOKED ON SITE** - All meats that are entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, pre-marinating, etc. will not be allowed either on or off the cook site prior to start of the cook-off as defined by the cook-off promoter. Meat may not be seasoned or marinated prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day before a cook-off.
2. **SANITATION** - All cooks are to prepare and cook in a sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the judging committee at any given time.
3. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES PER PIT** - CTBA does not permit multiple entries on one BBQ Pit. Only one team per BBQ Pit.
4. **COOK'S MEETING** - The HEAD JUDGE will be responsible to address the cooks on rules and judging procedures according to official CTBA rules and regulations.

Clarification on BBQ Pits - Any commercial or homemade trailered or un-trailered pit or smoker. May include gas or electricity to start natural fiber substance, wood or wood products. Electrical accessories such as spits, augers or force drafts are permitted. This includes pellet cookers. The use of propane or electric heat sources are still prohibited. The use of heat lamps or any other electrical heating or HOLDING device is prohibited.

5. **OPEN FIRES** - CTBA further recognizes that no ground pits will be used and that all burn down barrels will have some sort of safety barrier placed across the top or around the barrel. Promoter to include this information in the invitation and non-compliance could be grounds for disqualification.
6. **CATEGORIES** - Brisket, Pork Ribs and Chicken ARE THE ONLY CATEGORIES used for determining the Grand Champion or Overall Winner.
7. **CRITERIA FOR TURN IN SAMPLES** - One showpiece for each category plus 12 bite size pieces. Rib samples must have bone in it and can be any length as long as the lid will close. Each rib is a showpiece only turn in 12 NOT 13. Brisket slice shall be cut twice for bite size piece. There shall be no more than 12 bite size pieces in your turn in box.
8. **JUDGING TRAYS** - CTBA recommends the use of a Styrofoam tray with a hinged lid and without dividers or the best readily available judging container that is approximately 9 inches square on the bottom half. CTBA also states that silver foil must be used in the judging trays supplied by cookers. All judging containers shall be clean and free of obvious marks. Marked containers may be disqualified at the Head Judges' discretion. Cooks are responsible for ensuring the containers they receive are clean and undamaged. Cooks are also required to sign the duplicate ticket on your turn in box. No prize will be awarded if the matching duplicate ticket is not signed.
9. **JUDGING TRAY CONTENTS** - CTBA requires that the promoter and/or Head Judge advise all cooks entered into competition at any given event of the exact quantities and cuts of meats that will be placed into the judging tray. No exceptions permitted once decided.
10. **GARNISHES** - Unless specified by the cook-off promoter, any and all garnishes and condiments are prohibited. Meats may be cooked with sauces, but once cooking is completed, sauces or seasonings of any kind cannot be used. No sauce may be visible in the judging containers; this will be grounds for disqualification.
11. **ALL DECISIONS BY CTBA JUDGES REGARDING CTBA RULES ARE FINAL.**
12. **RULE VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES** - Any cooking team found to be in violation of the above stated rules are subject to being disqualified from the current cooking event and or season. Any infractions will be brought to the attention of the current CTBA officers who along with the Board of Directors will review the allegations and determine the consequence of the alleged action. Teams and or individual team members may be prohibited from competing in CTBA sanctioned cook offs for a period of time not to exceed 5 years.
