This course explores how you can establish projects that make social change in your communities. You will learn about the attributes that make a successful social entrepreneur, and work with others to develop and implement projects in your community.

WHO THIS COURSE IS FOR

This course is designed for young people who want to make a difference in their communities. You might want to join this course because you have an existing project. Or you may have an interest in setting up a project or organisation. Or perhaps you just want to learn more about this topic and gain skills you can put into practice.

You can join this course if you:

- Are **16 years old** or more
- Are a **refugee, internally displaced, asylum seeker or otherwise displaced**
- Have **not completed** secondary education
- Are **not currently enrolled** in a higher education programme
- Are **interested** in this topic and want to have **greater impact** on your community, through developing projects, improving projects and helping others to develop ideas
- Are **able to read, write and speak in English**. We are looking for people who have an **intermediate level (B1)**, and who are eager to learn. You do not need to be fluent in English.
- Are able to **access a smartphone** for 6 hours per week

SELECTION CRITERIA

We have a limited number of places available for this course. To be selected, you need to demonstrate in your application that you are motivated to join, have an interest in social entrepreneurship and becoming a changemaker.

Students who are not selected for one of the three learning hubs may also be given the opportunity to join the course online.

WHAT YOU WILL GAIN FROM THIS COURSE:




Develop the skills to become a social entrepreneur

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Here is an overview of the six week course (please note this is subject to change):

01

Orientation - Welcome to Sky School

Meet your team, your facilitator, discover how you will be learning and explore the Sky School Virtual Campus.

02

Team-building and Introduction to Social Entrepreneurship

Learn about yourself and others, your identity, your community, and what makes an effective team. Examine what social entrepreneurship is and learn about the social entrepreneurship cycle.

03

Idea Generation & Creativity

Examine the issues that the world and your community face. Learn about human-centred design. Find out what challenges you and your group are passionate about solving. Start to brainstorm ideas.

04

Week 04 - Idea Development

Work in groups to come up with concrete projects for tackling challenges, and develop your ideas further. You will also learn about developing a sustainable business model and ways to market your idea.

05

Week 05 - Testing of Projects

In your group, you will test your project in your community. You will learn how to measure the impact of your project, and how you can learn from testing to make your project stronger.

06

Week 06 - Impact and Reflection

You will present your projects to the other groups. You will reflect on the projects you have undertaken during the course and think about what next steps you will take to make change in your community.

HOW YOU WILL STUDY

For students who can access the learning hubs **in Athens, Amman and Kakuma**, you will learn through both online study and through face-to-face learning:



Online study - you will be able to access content, readings and exercises for each week via our smartphone app, Sky School Virtual Campus. You can study at any time and you will be able to communicate with fellow students and facilitators.



In person study - you will meet several times per week with your team and on-site facilitator, to undertake exercises and projects and to explore topics further.

For students studying online: if you based in a location where there is no learning hub, you can **study the whole course online**, with the assistance of our online facilitators.

Sky School is a not for profit organisation which provides open access courses to secondary education for displaced learners. We believe that displaced youth should be able to access education that enables them to finish their high school/secondary education, and which prepares them to become changemakers, peacemakers, and leaders in the future. The social entrepreneurship course is the equivalent of a pre-university high school level course. Please note that this is a stand-alone course and will not lead to a full high school diploma.
