Minutes

- II. Committee for Diversity and Inclusion

 - c. Motivated by a request from Dean Holloway; falls within YCC's scope and authority
 - d. Model for appointments to body
 - i. At-large appointments: solicit applications from the student body
 - ii. House model: cultural houses and LGBTQ center solicit applications for and select representatives
 - e. Recommendations
 - i. First: vote on whether this project continues
 - ii. If passes: pick model for appointments
 - iii. Finally: propose chosen model to Deans Holloway, Howard, Peck and Lizarribar for review
 - f. No quorum — conversation will continue
- III. Academic Integrity Policies at Yale
 - a. Presentation by Jackson Willis BK '19
 - b. No recommendations for vote after presentation; just wants to start conversation
 - c. All other Ivy League schools have established honor codes; Yale and MIT both don't have anything formal
 - d. Yale's ExComm reports are encouraging; indicate we might not need to change structure
 - e. Students overall feel instructors' policies are clear and Yale's academic integrity policies deter dishonesty/cheating/plagiarism
