## Minutes

*Please note that the minutes reflect the conversation held during the Council of Representatives meeting, but may not contain every comment and are not intended to reflect exact quotations. Comments in italics are notes to give context to the minutes. The layout of the minutes is the Presentation of the Issue, Presentation of the Discussion, and Recording of the Vote. Unless otherwise noted, the Presentation of the Issue is done by the person whose name is next to the heading for that issue. Comments by representatives or other attendees are preceded by their name (e.g. Jane: comment).*

- I. Course Evaluation System
  - a. Diksha: Not all professors may know about the flexibility feature in course evaluations - publicize this.
  - b. Daniel: Currently, feedback focuses on satisfaction, not learning benefit. Might want to focus more on these aspects. Female professors have worse ratings on satisfaction, but better for learning outcomes (social science research)
  - c. Joshua: How do professors feel about “show all responses”? Exists if students want to make specific comments that professors might not want other students to see.
  - d. Vote:
    - i. Group answers by demographic: YES
    - ii. Closed-ended questions: NO
    - iii. Consolidate open-ended questions: YES
    - iv. Anonymous feedback form open during term: YES
    - v. Customizing questions: YES
    - vi. Incentives? Require closed ended answers, only show questions answered: NO
- II. Second Semester Extracurricular Bazaar - Ryan Liu
  - a. Joel: Include activities you are involved in on Yale Facebook. Integrate existing resources
  - b. Christopher: Student groups - are they interested?
  - c. Carter: Lean more towards combining with existing bazaars such as Dwight Hall's
  - d. Vote: YES to both recommendations
- III. FroCo Compensation
  - a. Lauren: Number of hours worked vs. number paid equated to less than minimum wage; clarification of time commitment is important
  - b. Diksha: FroCos are less concerned with compensation than with mentorship. Not having a stipend would not have deterred them from signing up to be a froco, but they would like more money to spend on their freshmen
  - c. Carter: Seems like a large percentage of those surveyed thought that they were being paid appropriately
  - d. Vote:
    - i. Increase information: YES
    - ii. Change in compensation
      1. Increase compensation with stipend: NO
