How to Vote On Election Day, Nov 7

Polls open **6 AM to 7 PM** On that day, you *must* vote at the polling place where you are registered to vote. To find your polling place go to Dept. of Elections Citizen Portal: vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation

TAKE A VALID ID TO THE POLLS. Examples of Acceptable ID:

- *Virginia driver's license
- * Valid student ID
- * Gov't issued ID e.g., Passport, Military ID
- * Current utility bill
- * Current pay stub

Deadline to return Vote by Mail Ballot

VOTE BY MAIL ABSENTEE BALLOTS

****Witness signatures are NOT required on absentee ballots, but the last 4 digits of SSN and year of birth are required ****



- Vote by mail applications available at: Office of Elections, government centers, libraries, or apply online: elections.virginia.gov/voterinformation
- Mail your applications and voted ballot early in case USPS mail is delayed OR return to a monitored Drop Box at an early voting location during opening hours, in front of the Fairfax County Government Center 24/7, or at any polling places on Election Day
- Absentee voters who choose to vote in person or a polling place on Election Day should bring and surrender the ballot received in the mail
