
From Washington D.C.:

1. Head south on I-95 towards Richmond, VA	93.8 mi
2. Take Exit 76b towards US-1/Belvidere St./US-301	0.1 mi
3. Turn Left onto W. Leigh St.	<0.1 mi
4. Turn Right onto N Belvidere St / US-1	2.0 mi
5. Cross over the James River and make Left at first light - Semmes Avenue/US-60	0.2 mi


6. Follow Semmes for two blocks and make Left into Flood Wall parking area.

Approach (see map on right):

7. Follow the concrete sidewalk under the new Manchester Bridge and across the pedestrian bridge over the train tracks. After the bridge the path splits, head left down the hill, under the pedestrian and traffic bridges and then veer left, down the sandbag stairs to the base of the abutment. - 10 minutes



Approximately 2.0 hours - 96 mi




