Social Outing 3rd - Make your way to South Bank for a casual walk around the area looking for "Street Photography" style images. Southbank has markets running from 10am til 9pm. You can cross the bridge if you are up for the walk into the CBD, or if you like catch a train from home and start in the CBD crossing over to South Bank later. We will plan to meet for coffee and a rest at a local café (TBA) in the midafternoon. If you really want to make a day of it stay till after dark for some magical "Night City Scapes". This is an outing that hopefully could provide you with some images for our set subject of Street photography but also hands at work (at the markets), and nightscapes if you stay til dark. If you drive there is underground and street parking, but hopefully won't be too big a challenge.

Official Outing or 25th - Bribie Island Butterfly House. Bring your macro lenses and or telephoto zoom lenses for a beautiful day out at the butterfly house. Expect to be amazed at this wonderful walk through open air butterfly house. With newly emerged butterflies released daily you will be chasing these delightful creatures all day! There is tea and coffee making facilities on site. This is a great chance to catch some "up close" nature photos. I can recommend bringing a flash if you have one to help freeze the very fast-moving creatures. And tripods will just slow you down, so leave those at home. I am happy to help out on the day with anybody who needs a little help working out how best to shoot them. If you don't own a macro lens you will do just fine with your standard zoom lens.

We will meet out the front at 1:00pm and stay for as long as you like(closing time is 4pm, but I have been told it is not strict). The address is 208 First Ave, Bongaree.
