The PGM ONE summit creates an intentional space for black, indigenous, and people of color/the global majority who participate in US-based movements for environmental education, access, and justice; land sovereignty; conservation; climate justice; food justice; and others. The space supports participants to share, learn, collaborate, heal, celebrate, build community, find support, and practice uprooting the systems of oppression that operate upon us, between us, and within us. The community that results helps us understand and mobilize our collective power to transform ourselves, our movements, and society.

In September 2020, we will host the 4th annual PGM ONE summit in Chicago, IL. We are energized and dedicated to the community that has been cultivated over the past four years – from 180 people in 2017 to nearly 400 in 2019.
