

SEEKING PART-TIME WORSHIP LEADER

CANYON CREEK BAPTIST CHURCH, a 39-year-old church in Temple, Texas, is looking for a committed Christian with formal training and experience.

Temple is the “perfect” location in Central Texas—located on Interstate 35 a few minutes north of Interstate 14 in Belton.

Temple provides easy access to these major communities:

- 7 miles and 20 minutes to the University of Mary-Hardin Baylor in Belton
- 40 miles and 45 minutes to Baylor University in Waco
- 68 miles and just 1.3 hours north of Austin and the University of Texas
- 129 miles and 2.5 hours south of Dallas
- 150 miles and 3 hours north of San Antonio
- 168 miles and 3.5 hours northwest of Houston

Our previous Worship Pastor accepted another church’s call after 17 very successful years with us.

Our senior pastor, Dr. Ronnie Hood, has been with us 8 years. He has an earned Ph.D. from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. Our Youth & College Pastor, Josh Murray, recently joined us. Our Worship Leader will be accountable to the Senior Pastor.

Presently we have two Sunday morning worship services, one of which is designed principally for, but not limited to, the younger set.

Our Worship Leader must be a committed follower of Jesus Christ. Each week, he or she must be prepared spiritually and professionally to lead the congregation in corporate worship.

This part-time position will be a minimum of 20 hours per week.

Worship Leader’s qualifications will include sufficient training and experience to develop, organize and implement all of the activities of the music ministry. The Worship Leader will weave together the various elements of worship services in such a way that God is glorified, Christ is lifted up, and the worshippers are invited to humbly enter into the presence of the Living God. The elements of our worship at Canyon Creek Baptist Church include singing, praying, giving, Scripture reading, proclamation of the Word, personal testimony, the Lord’s Supper, baptism, and anything else that encourages the congregation to worship our holy and awesome God.

WORSHIP LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THESE:

1. Leads the congregation toward authentic worship through modeling and teaching such worship.
2. Coordinates planning of worship service with Senior Pastor, Organist, Pianist, and Praise Band leaders.
3. Selects hymns and praise songs for 10:30 a. m. Sunday service. All songs chosen should be biblically and theologically sound and performed in a way that invites the congregation to sing with hearts full of praise to our God. We want to be both celebratory and reflective in our music.
4. Delivers worship order for the bulletin to the secretary by each Thursday morning.
5. Plans with Senior Pastor special services such as Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday.
6. Rehearses with choir and band Wednesday nights and at special rehearsals.
7. Recruits and rehearses with a diverse team of vocalists, ensembles, and instrumentalists to use their talents in worship and praise opportunities.
8. Oversees leadership of all other choral groups, ensembles, and special groups such as children's choirs.
9. Prepares song lyrics slides, announcements, and video elements for screen-projected display at each worship service. Coordinates with A/V technicians.
10. Supervises maintenance of church-owned musical equipment.
11. Submits requests through the Finance Committee for the purchase of music, supplies, equipment, and instrument repairs within budget parameters.

EXPECTATIONS OF ALL MINISTRY STAFF MEMBERS AT CANYON CREEK BAPTIST CHURCH:

- Uphold a vital relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ and regularly study the Word of God.
- Foster a close relationship with their immediate personal family, other church staff, and the church family.
- Live a Christ-like example at home, in the church, and in the community.
- Promote and participate in the adult corporate ministries of our church.
- Take advantage of educational opportunities by attending available conferences or professional courses, consistent with budgetary provisions.
